Players

- Be a role model to other players, the community and anyone watching on from the sidelines.

Parents and Spectators

- Understand our players, both Junior and Senior, play this game for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage and applaud fair play in accordance with the laws of the game.
- Treat referees with the utmost respect and foster an environment both at home and at the ground where this is encouraged. Their decision is final.
- Respect and recognise the contribution the coaches, managers, volunteers and staff make to ensure your kids can play the game they love.
